Adolescent Brain Cognitive Development (ABCD)

This study is a National longitudinal study that uses cutting-edge technology to determine how childhood experiences (such as sports, videogames, social media, unhealthy sleep patterns, and smoking) interact with each other and with a child's changing biology to affect brain development and—ultimately—social, behavioral, academic, health, and other outcomes, over a period of ten years (located at MMC)
